They are losing a psychologist. NL staffing is better. Psychologists are hard to find. Med management is going great. Alluma- 2 care coordinators working out of the jail. Hired a NP that is local. They have had three staff that have left the Crookston schools so they may need to look at contracting a professional to provide telemed. Youth and Family is the most challenging to find staff. They had an NWA board meeting- they have an enthusiastic board so excited to see what they are able to bring in- Looking at a possible corporate foster care. Kathy and Shauna sat in on the Crisis focus group surrounding the Crisis funding. Geography- distance- social determinant factors. Effective July 1 DHS and the existing CCBHC have reentered the Federal demonstration. Good for MN as it will bring in around 30 million dollars more. Legislative session- IRTS and residential- those licensed facilities will now start getting MEI inflationary- Ucare- Jennifer Garber- VP is leaving Ucare within a couple weeks. She has been with them for 4 years and will be greatly missed. They will continue functioning as they have been. BCBS- sent out DHS survey around Crisis services. Digital platforms for incentive- see a provider within 7 days. Will be claims based rather than having to submit. Medica- They are doing a gap in care campaign. They are working with the counties and trying to get the word out. If anyone needs funding, they have some available. County innovation fund- Medicaid population-this funding can cover trainings, events, etc. BH side- prepaid psychology appointments are available long term as well as immediate. WITW- they have been invited to the 9th African summit and have been President's daughter from Africa is coming to speak about MH which is huge as the stigma is very profound back in Africa.
