Their Utilization Review Committee consists of inpatient psychiatrists, psychologists, nursing, nursing leadership, and utilization review staff. They meet quarterly to review a random sampling of referrals that were denied admission. Factors they look at when considering appropriateness of the denial include the patient referral information, current patient population, any admission restrictions, staffing levels, etc.
