They have COVID at NL so they have to halt admissions for two weeks, but if you do have a referrals please still send in. IP Bed availability has been extremely difficult lately.  Alluma: Having a community response to crisis- having meetings to discuss how we address crisis moving forward.  Using the intercept model as the framework on how to develop the crisis response system. Then replicate in every county. Care and Share, LEC, County & Alluma.  Care Coordinator Supervisor just came on board- cultural liaison positions are posted. Crisis team is fully staffed.  Licensed Psychologist is moving on to another opportunity, so they are looking at hiring for this position or work with someone to potentially contract for this service. Care coordination: this group will not see a huge impact initially as they have a lot of work to do internally initially. Community response: Tri county corrections- look into prescribing practices. Alluma will be opening several Co-located satellite clinics in the coming year. Looking into where they will be and what will that look like. This would be full time and long term presence of Alluma.  LifeCare: Just transitioning with Jan retiring. 3 full time staff. They serve Warroad one day a week and telehealth the other days. Looking at advertising. They are not currently filling Jan's position. Jan will remain on very part time and her focus will be community wellness work.  Ucare: they implemented a new claims processing system. Hopefully everything will be much smoother for those that are billing us.
